

"Move for web - Win 2 cinema tickets" – Competition Rules

1. COMPETITION

PwC Belgium, acting in its own name and for its own account and in the name and for the account of the other Belgian members of the PricewaterhouseCoopers International Limited network, each of which is a separate and independent legal entity, of Woluwe Garden, Woluwedal 18, 1932 Sint-Stevens-Woluwe (hereinafter "PwC") is organising a competition called "Move for web - win 2 cinema tickets". The competition runs from 15.11.2011 until midnight on 29.02.2012. Competition entries are free of charge, without any purchase obligation and the competition is run over the internet by means of an electronic entry form. The date of entry using the said electronic entry form constitutes evidence of the date of entry.

2. COMPETITION ENTRIES

The competition is open to any private individual who is resident in Belgium with the exception of the staff, Directors, Partners and registered business relations of PwC and any person that is involved in organising this competition in the course of his business.

In order to take part, competitors need do no more than complete the survey, which can be opened via the PwC web site, and then answer the competition questions.

Competitors must correctly complete the online entry form by midnight on 29.02.2012, i.e. must correctly answer the 2 competition question and fill in their name, address and e-mail address

Incomplete or incorrectly completed entry forms will be disqualified. Each entrant may take part only once. If any entrant takes part more than once, only his first entry will be deemed valid.

Taking part in the competition implies unconditional acceptance of these competition rules and of any decision by the organiser. Any attempt at fraud shall entail immediate disqualification of the entrant. Printing, spelling, typographical and other similar errors may not be founded on as constituting any obligation on PwC whatsoever.

3. PRIZES

A total of 25 double tickets (cinema vouchers) to Kinopolis will be given away, each with a value of €18 (2 x€9).

These prizes are subject to change. The value of the ticket is not stated on the cinema vouchers.

These double tickets enable 2 persons to attend a showing of a standard film (= normal box office price).

4. AWARD OF PRIZES

Tie-breaker question:

How many people will have completed this questionnaire by midnight on 29.02.2012?

The 25 winners will be those entrants that answer the question correctly and give the correct answer to the tie-breaker or come closest to the correct answer. Each winner will receive a double ticket, each to the value of €18 (2 x €9). In the case of a dead heat, the winner will be selected on the basis of the date and time at which his answer is received on the competition server. Only one prize will be awarded per person, per family and per household.

Within four weeks after the competition end-date, the winners will be notified personally and their prize will be sent to them via De Post/La Poste (ordinary post). The prize will be sent to the winner's address as stated in the online entry form.

The prize can only be awarded to the winner. Prizes cannot be exchanged, are non-transferable and non-refundable and may not be sold.
